

The Community Partnership Program identifies and develops private, educational, law enforcement and faith-based relationships to enhance the quality of community supervision for our clients. Collaborative partnerships with all community stakeholders are vital to the success and mission of HCCSCD.

Collaborative partners allow HCCSCD to embark on a process of community engagement in order to build a sustainable system for delivering supportive services directly to our clients at no additional cost. It is through this system that our clients under supervision are not only held accountable for their behavior, but are also provided opportunities to grow and develop in a manner that increases their chances of success.

The CPP's resources include non-financial agreements with faith based and community initiatives that have resulted in the establishment of five satellite offices. The satellite offices support our Regions by expanding their outreach to various communities throughout Harris County.

The satellite offices provide standard reporting (office visits) as court ordered, community service opportunities, and participation in relevant and supportive programming. Programs and services at each location vary dependent upon those available at each reporting site and may include.
