2. Docket 564 initially marked out and rewritten on the following page.
3. Page 580 does not exist.
4. Dockets from 566 to 667 are missing.
5. Docket 686 refers to page 616 which does not exist
6. Docket case numbers may also refer to page numbers as indicated by the JP.
7. Where there is more than one case per page, the cases are assigned an alpha number.
8. Docket number 910 ends the chronological sequence of cases.
9. Docket numbers 523 and following are placed at the end of the book following number 910.
