**Sex:** Male

**Age:** 55-70

**Race:** Estimate based on anthropological analysis. The skull has both *Asian* and *Black* characteristics, so decedent could be either or a mix of both. Dark kinky hair found in association with body

**Stature:** 66.5 – 70.5 inches

**Weight:** NA

**State of remains:** Mostly skeletonized

**Property:** Starter brand gray sweatpants size medium, and blue plaid Fruit of the Loom brand boxer shorts size small.

**Identifiers:** Healed fracture near the midline of the frontal bone (forehead), which likely is associated with a previous injury. Skeletal evidence of arthritis of the lower back, shoulders, and knees (individual would likely have suffered chronic mild pain in these areas).
